Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends the rejection of all bids for Wood Oaks Green Park Culvert Replacement and Entrance Drive Renovation and to defer the project until 2019 when appropriate funding is available.

Background & Analysis:

This project includes the removal of the existing storm culvert and end sections, construction of new precast culvert and end sections, regrading, installation of a new B6.12 concrete curb, construction of new asphalt pavement, pavement striping, construction of new timber post and wood guardrail, and site restoration.

Per the engineer, this project was anticipated to come in at or under budget. After bids were opened, it was realized that the construction bids were grossly over our projected budget. In addition, MWRD is requiring a qualified wetland specialist to determine whether the proposed grading impacts a riparian environment. In order to determine the riparian environment, we will need to submit the Wetland Delineation Report to the Army Corps for a Jurisdictional Determination (JD). It is the opinion of Gewalt Hamilton Engineers that this area will be regulated by the Corps due to the storm sewer pipe connection to Lake Shermerville. This means a construction permit could take six months to obtain, which will most likely involve revisions to appease the Army Corps.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends the approval of the Meadowhill Aquatic Center Children's Pool Painting base bid in the amount of \$22,200 from Nedrow Decorating, Inc. of Aurora, Illinois.

Background & Analysis:

This project consists of the preparation and painting of the children's pool at Meadowhill Aquatic Center. Since four or more layers of paint have been previously applied, the pool surface must be stripped back to the substrate before painting again, otherwise paint will not adhere and eventually flake off. The pool was originally painted in 2006 and has been repainted multiple times since then. The last time it was painted was in 2012.

Staff suggests we approve the pool painting base bid of \$22,200.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends the renewal of the Waste Hauling and Recycling base bid for two years in the amount of \$25,696.55 from Lakeshore Recycling Systems of Morton Grove, Illinois.

Background & Analysis:

The bid for Waste Hauling and Recycling was opened last year on June 29, 2017. The bid requested three years of pricing, however Lakeshore Recycling Systems was a new vendor, therefore staff recommended a one- year agreement, with the ability to renew for two additional years upon successful completion of the first year. The Board of Commissioners was informed of the one-year agreement with Lakeshore Recycling Systems on July 18, 2017, since the amount for the one-year agreement was under \$20,000.

Staff suggests the renewal of the agreement for two years with Lakeshore Recycling Systems in the amount of \$12,534.90 for year two and \$13,161.65 for year three, for a two-year total of \$25,696.55, based on satisfactory service throughout the past year.
