#### **Staff Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the approval of the professional services contract amendment for architectural services with Wight & Company, Darien, Illinois for architectural services at a fixed fee of one million-fifty thousand dollars (\$1,050,000) based on the cost of construction work, compared to the original fee of \$1,494,500.

#### **Background & Analysis:**

Upon severing the partnership with the Northern Suburban Special Recreation Association (NSSRA), the Agreement between the Park District and Wight & Company needed to be amended. The architect fee was a fixed fee based on an original \$21,350,000 construction cost of the building. Upon redesigning the building, the revised construction cost has been calculated at \$13,600,000 and a fee of \$1,050,000 with a not to exceed amount of \$20,000 for Reimbursable Expenses.

#### **Staff Recommendation:**

Staff recommends the approval of the professional services contract amendment for construction management services with Corporate Construction Services, Downers Grove, Illinois for construction management services at a fee of 6.8% of the cost of the work, currently estimated at \$13,600,000 with a not to exceed amount of \$10,000 for Reimbursable Expenses.

#### **Background & Analysis:**

Upon severing the partnership with the Northern Suburban Special Recreation Association (NSSRA), the Agreement between the Park District and Corporate Construction Services needed to be amended. The Construction Manager-As Advisor fee is based on the construction cost of the building.
