

## **Public and Cosmic Skating Guidelines**

- Food and beverages are not allowed on the ice at any time
- Skating in a manner that endangers or interferes with other skater's safety or pleasure is strictly prohibited
- Roughness, excessive speeding or weaving through other skaters is prohibited
- Incidents or destruction are to be reported to the supervisor on duty
- Skating guards are in completed control of the ice surface and their warnings and decisions must be heeded
- No tag or games of any kind are permitted on or off the ice
- No bullying or teasing of skaters or staff will be permitted
- No videos or cameras of any kind are allowed on the ice
- No hockey sticks or pucks are allowed
- No more than two people may skate together
- No one is permitted on the ice without skates
- While on the ice, skaters must keep moving
- Skaters are not allowed to carry children or secondary items such as cameras, handbags, etc. while skating
- Patrons must not sit on, lean over, or leave articles on the dasher boards
- No pets are permitted on the premises
- No figure skating or backward skating is permitted except in designated areas
- All exits are to be kept clear
- No one is allowed on the ice during resurfacing
- Throwing snowballs or any objects is strictly prohibited
- Figure skating harness usage during public session is prohibited
- Patrons are not allowed past the third row of the bleachers while wearing skates
- Figure skating maneuvers are prohibited during busy sessions. Discretion will be left up to Northbrook Park District staff.
- Consumption of alcohol and other intoxicants is strictly forbidden on park district property
- The Northbrook Park District is not responsible for any personal items stolen or left within or around the premises.
