### **Staff Recommendation:**

Staff recommends approval of Resolution 23-R-4, the Open Space Land Acquisition and Development (OSLAD) Grant Application Resolution of Authorization for the Meadowhill Aquatic Center Renovation Project.

### **Background and Analysis:**

OSALD is a grant program offered through the Illinois Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) that provides funding assistance up to \$600,000 for approved development (construction) projects for eligible Development/Renovation projects which include (but are not limited to):

- Picnic and playground facilities
- Outdoor nature interpretive facilities
- Sports courts and play fields
- Swimming pools, beaches and bathhouses
- Campgrounds and fishing piers
- Winter sports facilities
- Park roads and paths, parking, utilities and restrooms
- Architectural/engineering (A/E) services necessary for proper design and construction of approved project components

On July 3, 2023, the IDNR announced a \$56 million appropriation for OSLAD matching grants in 2024. With the opportunity for an OSLAD grant, the District has prepared a Meadowhill Aquatic Center renovation concept plan that qualifies for the FY 2024 cycle. The District has received two OSLAD grants in the last two fiscal years totaling \$1,000,000.

The grant timeline requires the District to meet the following criteria by August 31, 2023:

- Board of Commissioners approval of a Resolution of Authorization. (attached)
- Hold an advertised Community Open House input meeting to review the project Concept Plan. The Community Open House will be held on Tuesday, August 1, 2023 from 6:30-7:30pm at the Meadowhill Aquatic Center.

The Resolution has been included for consideration in the Committee Meeting packet. Authorization of the Resolution is a required component of the grant but does not commit the District to apply for the grant.

## NORTHBROOK PARK DISTRICT

The Board will have three additional opportunities to provide direction on the concept plan before August 31. In addition, the timeline allows for the inclusion of additional community feedback into the plan.
