INFORMATIONAL ITEMS/VERBAL UPDATES

Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary Status Wood Oaks Green Park

Director Leiner announced that Wood Oaks Green Par has been designated as a Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary. The District proudly holds the distinction of being the first Park District in Illinois to achieve this designation for two of its parks. Wood Oaks Green Park stands as an achievement, being only the third park in Illinois to receive this certification. Congratulations to Superintendent Meyer and his team on this achievement.

ComEd Grant Wood Oaks Green Park

Director Leiner announced that the District has been awarded a \$15,234 grant from ComEd to provide new energy-efficient light fixtures for the walking path and parking lot at Wood Oaks Green Park. Through a \$6,909 grant match, the District was able to secure 53 new LED light fixtures that will attach directly to the existing light poles.

Meadowhill Aquatic Center Renovation Concept

Director Leiner introduced Jason Estes and Annabella Orlando from FGMArchitects.
